- 2) One Head Coach Indoor Male High Performance Team
- 3) One Head Coach Beach High Performance Team (2019 Western Summer Games only)

End Date: April 2020 – (with the ability to continue in the role until Canada Games 2021.)

HIGH PERFORMANCE COACHING POSITION(S) DESCRIPTION:

The main objective of the program is to introduce athletes to a high performance-training environment. The program will include all aspects of sport including physical, technical, mental, emotional and tactical training.

Associate Coach:

Volleyball Nunavut will be using a different coaching model for this Canada Games cycle. Scott Schutz will be named the Associate Coach for all teams. The Associate Coach will work with the coaches to develop all training aspects for the teams as well as be involved in the training of the athletes at all times.

The Head Coaches will continue to be the lead contact with the athletes as well as all coaching during matches.

The Associate Coach will work with coaches to develop game plans for all matches.

Necessary Coaching Requirements:

- Familiarize with the Long-term Athlete Development model for Volleyball in Canada.
- Valid Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Screening
- Experience monitoring and developing athletes 18 yrs & younger with multiple learning styles
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Excellent interpersonal/ analytical/ evaluation/ organization skills
- Self-initiator / proactive
- Ability to develop and foster relationships



ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

The duties of the successful candidate may include, but are not necessarily limited to the following:

- Contribute to the identification and selection of athletes
- Work with 'Associate Coach' to design, develop and implement all practice, training and game plans.
- Coach athletes during all training and competition.
- Participate in camps/athlete workshops programmed for the training group
- Contribute to periodized training plan, according to athlete training & competition schedule
- Participate in coach development workshops as programmed for the coaches
- Provide timely and effective communication with parents, guardians and community coaches
- Plan & lead training sessions
- Teach technical and tactical aspects consistent with that of Volleyball Nunavut's plan
- Develop a 'team structure' that allows for success in a Major Games Setting.
- Work in close collaboration with Scott Schutz and/or assigned mentor coach
- Work in collaboration with VN Board of Directors
- Track, monitor, and guide athletes in their progress for training, competitions, and partnerships
- Participate in season-end evaluation of athletes, and program review
- Develop a communication plan that allows for all athletes and parents to be informed of all important dates, plans and events.
- Be a leader with all team fundraising initiatives.
