

COMMUNITY VOLLEYBALL FUNDING GRANTS

Volleyball Nunavut will be launching a Community Volleyball Funding Grants. This Grant is to help communities in Nunavut develop and host community leagues and tournaments throughout the year.

The VBNU – Community Event Grant provides funding for communities which work to meet the following through volleyball.

- encourage active healthy lifestyles
- build strong communities
- nurture lifelong participation in sport
- facilitate development of events
- enhance social sustainability
- support effective management and operation of sport, recreation and cultural facilities

Communities seeking funding support from Volleyball Nunavut through the grant program administered by should be aware of and aligned with one or more these core principles.

The **Community Volleyball Funding Grant** is to recognize and support events that enrich the community through volleyball and sport.

The **Community Volleyball Funding Grant** is application-based and consists of three category amounts. For each category, grants are available to offset event-related expenses.

1) Community League Grant - \$2000.00 + Clothing Prizes

- Communities that will be hosting a community League for 8+ weeks.
- Must have competitions at least once a week.
- League must be completed by March 31, 2022.
- Can be a 3 vs 3, 4 vs 4, 5 vs 5 or 6 vs 6. Co-ed or separate men's and women's leagues.

2) Community Tournament Grants - \$1200.00 + Clothing Prizes

- Communities that will be hosting minimum of **two** community tournaments.
- Tournaments must be completed by March 31, 2022.
- Can be a 3 vs 3, 4 vs 4, 5 vs 5 or 6 vs 6. Co-ed or Men's and Women's Tournaments.



COMMUNITY VOLLEYBALL FUNDING GRANTS

1. ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for the following funding grants, the following criteria must be met:

Community League Grant - \$2000.00 + Clothing Prizes

- Communities that will be hosting a community League for 8+ weeks.
- Must have competitions at least once a week.
- League must be completed by March 31, 2022.
- Can be a 3 vs 3, 4 vs 4, 5 vs 5 or 6 vs 6. Co-ed or separate men's and women's leagues.
- Event must be sanctioned through Volleyball Nunavut <u>See Sanctioning.</u>
- All Participants must be <u>'Recreational Members'</u> of Volleyball Nunavut <u>See Membership</u>

Community Tournament Grants - \$1200.00 + Clothing Prizes

- Communities that will be hosting minimum of **two** community tournaments.
- Tournaments must be completed by March 31, 2022.
- Can be a 3 vs 3, 4 vs 4, 5 vs 5 or 6 vs 6. Co-ed or Men's and Women's Tournaments.
- Event must be sanctioned through Volleyball Nunavut <u>See Sanctioning</u>.
- All Participants must be 'Recreational Members' of Volleyball Nunavut See Membership

2. ELIGIBILE EXPENSES:

Grant funding can be used to offset the costs of the following:

- Equipment Equipment needed to host event.
- Referee Costs Such as match fees, accommodations, airfare, per diem, etc.
- Marketing and Advertising of event
- Event Logistics (security, food preparation, etc.)
- Administration costs (printing, hosting costs)

3. IN-ELIGIBLE EXPENSES:

Grant funding cannot be used for the following:

- Costs for food or beverages
- Infrastructure and/or Capital Costs
- Prize Money
- Facility / Gym Rentals Communities should be donating facilities for such events.
